Sample Extracts from Natal Chart Reports

This is not a full Natal Chart Report, these are just extracts of what you can expect. For example, your Signs, Planets, Houses, Aspects, Chart Patterns and Specialities

Sun in Libra in the 5th House

The Sun sign represents our highest self. It is what we identify with and who we believe to be. What truly drives, inspires and motivates us are related to the Sun sign.

Sun in Libra individuals need to feel cooperative, in the know and intelligent in order to feel fulfilled and essentially, happy. The Sun is where we 'shine', and this can be uncomfortable in the people-oriented sign of Libra, especially as the Sun is a dominant, self-serving planet. To achieve equilibrium, there must be an ability to put your foot down and set boundaries, meaning saying yes or no only when you feel it is right for you to do so. Asking yourself what would fulfil you. Sun in Libra natives strive to be balanced, informed, and patient.

Sun in 5th House:

You love to express your creativity and generous nature - allowing you to become popular within your social circles! You are easy to get along with, helpful, accommodating, creative, full of unconditional love and entertaining! You can really light up a room with this placement, and everybody wants you on their team. You open up your heart energy by allowing yourself to be yourself, 95% of the time. Although, this can backfire on you, since not everybody is full of love like you, you don't let this deter you from the thing that inspires you to do this - connection and love. You love to connect with people, and your warm and friendly nature allows others to feel that they can be themselves around you, which is beautiful! You do not judge, or criticize others, as their feelings matter to you, and above all, you wish that everybody would just get along in a peaceful setting.

Moon in Leo in the 12th House:

The moon deals with our deepest emotional state, needs, our mothers or our more 'maternal' parent, childhood, habits, instinctive thoughts, our innermost feelings and tells us what brings us the most comfort. The moon tells us what brings the most satisfaction and what we need to do to feel at ease with ourselves.

You are someone who is innately proud, expressive and artistic and you react warmly and generously to people and situations. Your sense of pride is what makes you feel secure. You are thoughtful, sensitive and very artistic! More than what you give yourself credit for....

Moon in the 12th house individuals struggle to validate their own emotions. The 12th House in Astrology is the House of the 'unknown' and it's energy can be confusing until we learn how to work with it. You try to control your emotions due to fear of 'drowning in them'. You feel the world so intensely that you can absorb people's energies quickly, making you want to withdraw from the world.

People that are emotional vampires who, subconsciously or consciously, may be drawn to your empathetic spirit but you must remember it is not your job to fix people, nor do you have to 'set yourself on fire' to keep them warm. If after spending time with someone, they make you feel drained, empty or used, it is best to have boundaries in order to protect yourself.

There is a conflicting energy between your emotions and what you feel you 'should' be doing. You may feel guilt when you express yourself but in a way, you need to in order to feel seen. Keep expressing yourself and keep shining on! You were brought to this world to celebrate your authentic self, not to shame yourself into hiding or concealing your expression.

Moon in 12th house individuals are very artistic and oftentimes they feel at peace when creating some form of art. 'The Moon here has the most difficulty being openly expressed and even understood, which can over time play out in two basic ways: either the person struggles with emotional sensitivities and fear of expressing emotions for many years (even throughout life) or they seek self-protection via more uplifted, spiritual and/or psychic means'.

You see your mother as someone who takes on the themes of the 12th house. She may be someone who often is oblivious to their own feelings, that she invalidates the world around her. You saw her as someone who has been hurt by the world and is still coming to terms with it herself. The mother/child relationship here is a confusing one and you often see your mother as someone who is a mystery to you, a mystery that you often try to solve. You feel as though there is something 'missing' or absent about your mother and feel as though she continually misunderstands you.

You may feel like you are invalidated (12th house) when you express your emotions (Leo Moon) in front of her, or, she doubts you or believes that you are lying (Again, 12th house themes)

This may be helpful, it is something I have read with 12th house moon individuals: 'most parents will always nurture for their child in the way that resonates with their own needs based on their own nurturing wounds from their own childhood and teenagehood, which are not always in line with what their child actually needs. This is the universe's

way to send us karmic lessons through our children to help us understand that every human being is unique and has unique needs, even though on a grander scheme of things we all have lots of similarities'. (https://astrosalt.com/author/saltastro/)

You are someone who is charitable, philathronpic and has many hidden talents. You genuinely want to see peace in the world and people are drawn to your generous and kind nature.

Gemini Ascendant:

Gemini Ascendants are naturally vivacious, inquisitive, and flexible. Individuals born under this rising sign are frequently witty, chatty, and intellectually curious. They are constantly keen to pick up new skills and have thought-provoking discussions. They are affable and easy to connect with because of their innate charisma and sociability, which frequently draws people to them with ease. Regardless of their age, this placement also lends them a youthful, vivacious presence, and they are usually recognised for their quick thinking and multitasking skills.

Gemini Ascendants are quite flexible and can easily adapt to a variety of circumstances and individuals. They may find themselves continuously looking for new experiences or altering their environment to keep life exciting since they thrive on variety. They thrive on variety and may find themselves constantly seeking new experiences or changing their surroundings to keep life interesting. However, this restless energy can sometimes make them appear inconsistent or indecisive, as they may struggle with committing to one path or opinion.

Their ruling planet, Mercury, blesses them with strong communication skills, making them natural storytellers and persuasive speakers. They can excel in roles that require quick thinking and adaptability, such as teaching, writing, or any field that involves networking or negotiation. On the downside, this placement may lead to a tendency to be overly scattered or easily distracted, as their minds are always racing with new ideas and possibilities.

It is worth noting that Gemini Ascendants can be inconsistent, often believing they can navigate life through sheer talk without needing to know everything. They may have a nervous streak and could be prone to anxiety disorders, but they live for gossip and are always in the know. They are hilarious, witty, and highly intelligent,

making them formidable in any argument, as they can verbally obliterate anyone who challenges them. Fun and easy-going, they thrive on variety and are open to new experiences, which makes them incredibly lovable and easy to be friend. This is a truly charismatic and social placement to have.

Chiron in Scorpio in 4th House:

In Astrology, Chiron is known for being the 'wounded healer'. Steve Mcfadden describes Chiron as our 'deepest psychological wound, and highlights how we approach that wound to heal it. By knowing and understanding your natal Chiron, you have profound understanding and practical tools'.

Oftentimes with Chiron in the 4th house there is a traumatic and possibly abusive childhood and there is a lot of bitterness towards your childhood... there is potential psychological damage from childhood and the family, thus making the concept of 'home' broken or distorted in some way and you may have an extremely hard time accepting love from others, love may not feel real...but people do love and care for you, even if you don't see it...they do.

Chiron in 4th house natives have to fight hard for inner-peace, but these people are true warriors, it is very hard to break their spirit. The relationship with your mother may be strained in some form, you may have seen her as someone who is damaged and needs saving.

You may be frightened to have your own family one day, or to have the parent-child relationship and may feel overwhelmed and dispirited by your family history in some form of another. However, you easily empower others to heal themselves, people's troubles are treated with sensitivity and kindness, and people do appreciate this so much. Chiron in 4th house people would feel amazing fulfilment in areas such as family counselling and teaching. Also, there may be issues with the chest area or heart.

Your aspects:

Aspects in a Natal Chart describe the strength of the relationship between the planets at the time of your birth. It adds a more in-depth insight into how your Natal Chart works, depending on the strength between the planets. For this section, I have

only written about your tightest (meaning that they are more likely to be felt by you, I write only to an orb of 2°) aspects.

Venus Sextile North Node orb: 0 °

You possess flexibility, adjustability, and generousity. This aspect is tender and kind-hearted, and also it is worth mentioning that you are incredibly charming and alluring when you want to be. You have a propensity to be overly sentimental with the added note of Jupiterian quality. Venus in connection to your North Node enhances Venus' appeal and increases your level of popularity. This results in a personality that is trustworthy and capable of acting on affectionate impulses. You may find yourself wanting to have Venusian qualities as you think about your future, and want to have glamorous items surrounding you.

Uranus Conjunction MC orb: 0 $^{\circ}$

When Uranus is in conjunction with your Midheaven, there is a strong sense of intuition surrounding your life's purpose alongside always being prepared to act in sudden situations. When you feel as though your life is out of your control, you could experience heightened emotional imbalances. This calls you to pay attention to your intuition and what your heart is telling you, not your mind. This placement also harbours uniqueness, following your heart towards what you want to do, assertiveness, confidence to grow in the face of adversity, and to truly follow your own rules. This placement is excellent in remaining professional in times of uncertainty and unpredictability, and keeping an open mind during these times will serve you well.

Venus Sextile Mars (0'44)

It's important for you to gain clarity about the underlying values that are most important to you. These will help to guide you in discerning where to target

your attention so that you do not become scattered or distracted by having too many interests to fully develop. If you run up against obstacles or setbacks, don't give up. Instead, make an effort to find supportive resources, as you are someone who is able to work well with others. Part of your success within collaborative partnerships or teams comes from your willingness to compromise with others, rather than needing to enforce your will or seize control. Since you also have a talent for motivating others to follow their passions, you will benefit greatly from forming mutually supportive relationships. You and the other person are able to help one another achieve goals

Patterns and specialities within your Natal Chart: Multiple Planet Square:

Your multiple planet square involving Chiron in Scorpio, the Midheaven (MC) and Uranus in Aquarius, and Neptune in Capricorn introduces an intense, powerful and challenging energy in your chart, urging you to face deep personal wounds and societal expectations while managing the tension between your ideals and reality, or your head vs. your heart.

Chiron in Scorpio points to a profound, often hidden wound related to trust, intimacy, and personal power. This placement indicates that your healing journey involves exploring your emotional depths, confronting your fears, and channelling your pain into something beautiful or productive, as opposed to destruction. The square to your MC and Uranus in Aquarius creates tension between your healing process and your public or professional life. Uranus strengthens this drive for independence and originality, making you inclined to break free from traditional roles and societal norms.

Neptune in Capricorn adds complexity by adding a layer of idealism and potential confusion regarding your goals. Neptune's influence can blur the lines between reality and illusion, particularly when it comes to your ambitions and how you structure your life. The square between Neptune and Chiron suggests that your wounds may stem from disillusionment or difficulty in manifesting your dreams

practically. It is important to add that one of your strengths is perseverance, despite feelings of disillusionment.

This multiple planet square challenges you to cultivate closeness between your deep emotional needs (Scorpio Chiron), your desire for freedom and innovation (Aquarius Uranus), and the necessity to ground your ideals in reality (Capricorn Neptune). While the tension may feel overwhelming at times, it also offers significant potential for growth, which you know is within you, even in times of overwhelming stress. By navigating this, you can develop a stronger sense of self, clarify your path, and bring your unique contributions to the world in an authentic and impactful manner!

Air Grand Trine:

Having a Grand Trine in Air in your chart blesses you with a natural gift for communication, intellectual pursuits, and abstract thinking. Ideas flow to you effortlessly, and you can articulate them in a way that captivates others. You may find that you easily perceive connections between concepts that others might miss, offering you a unique perspective. This aspect also enhances your social skills, allowing you to engage in conversations with ease and charm. You flourish in intellectually stimulating settings and feel most energised when engaging in deep discussions or exploring new ideas. The harmonious energy of this Grand Trine consistently fuels your mental strength, making you a powerful presence in any intellectual or creative endeayours.

Emphasis on the Bottom Right Quadrant of your Natal Chart Wheel:

When looking at your Natal Chart, most of the placements are in the lower right quadrant, with the focus on the lower and right areas of your astrological wheel, emphasising personal and relational themes. This quadrant mainly covers the 4th, 5th, and 6th houses, which relate to aspects such as home, family, creativity, and daily routines.

The prevalence of planets in this quadrant reveals a strong inclination towards personal growth and inner development, emphasising emotional safety, security and nurturing your closest connections and relationships. The emphasis on this quadrant suggests that you are profoundly engaged with your domestic sphere, family life, and personal well-being, often finding fulfilment through intimate

relationships and creative expression. Your chart's emphasis here points to a preference for introspective activities, personal improvement, and practical daily tasks, with a diminished focus on public recognition or career aspirations. This pattern accentuates a tendency to find satisfaction in personal achievements and maintaining harmony within one's immediate environment, reflecting a more introspective or reserved approach to life and success.
